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CM Revanth Reddy Seeks Centre's Approval for RRR North, Greenfield Highway Projects

Seeks early approval for Northern RRR, Future City–Bandar Port corridor, and key national road infrastructure to boost Telangana's connectivity and economic growth.

New Delhi, July 14 (The Journalist Post): Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy on Tuesday urged Union Minister for Road Transport and Highways Nitin Gadkari to expedite approval for key road infrastructure projects in Telangana, including the Northern section of the Regional Ring Road (RRR), the Future City–Bandar Port Greenfield Highway, and an alternative six-lane highway connecting Mancherial to Hyderabad. During a meeting held at the Union Minister's residence in New Delhi, the Chief Minister requested the Centre to secure Union Cabinet approval for the pending Northern section of the Regional Ring Road, stating that 95 percent of land acquisition



tion for the northern corridor has already been completed. He also sought early approval for the southern section, emphasizing that simultaneous execution of both corridors would reduce project costs and accelerate completion.Revanth Reddy also highlighted the importance of the proposed Future City–Bandar Port Greenfield Highway, saying the project was envisioned under the Andhra Pradesh Reorganisation Act. He requested the Union Minister to grant immediate approval for the highway, which will connect Hyderabad

Alampur, July 14 (The Journalist Post): Deputy Chief Minister and Finance Minister Mallu Bhatti Vikramarka on Monday alleged that the previous BRS government pushed Telangana into a debt burden of Rs8.21 lakh crore, forcing the present Congress government to shoulder massive financial liabilities while simultaneously implementing welfare and development programmes.Addressing a public meeting at Julekal village in Vaddepalli mandal of Alampur Assembly constituency, Bhatti Vikramarka said the Congress government inherited a financially stressed state after what he termed a decade of misgovernance, corruption, and poor financial management under the previous regime. 'Gram Swaraj' is the Path to Telangana's Future Telangana Will Strengthen Only When Villages Strengthen

The millions of people who fought for the formation of Telangana did not do so merely to secure a new state. They dreamt of governance resting in the hands of the people, of village development, of every family becoming economically strong, and of ensuring employment for every youth, dignity for every farmer, and security for every worker. with Andhra Pradesh through a modern transport corridor. “The Chief Minister explained that the proposed 12-lane highway from Bharat Future City to Bandar Port via Amaravati would reduce the Hyderabad–Vijayawada travel distance by nearly 100 kilometres, significantly improving freight movement and logistics between Hyderabad and the coastal port. “He further sought early forest clearances for the proposed Mannanur–Srisailam Elevated Corridor, stating that the project would improve connectivity to the Nallamala Sanctuary, Srisailam Temple, and the Srisailam Reservoir. “Revanth Reddy also requested the Centre to sanction a six-lane alternative highway from Mancherla to Hyderabad as an alternative to the existing Rajiv Highway. He assured that the Telangana government would undertake the required land acquisition and stated that the new corridor would boost agricultural development, trade, and industrial growth across the region. “Nalgonda MP Raghuvir Reddy, Roads & Buildings Special Chief Secretary Vikas Raj, Government Advisor and Ex-officio Special Chief Secretary K. Ramakrishna Rao, Special Secretary (Coordination) Advait Kumar Singh, and senior officials were present during the meeting.

Telangana to Launch 'Indiramma LIG Housing' Scheme in QUAR Area on July 20

Ponguleti Srinivasa Reddy announced that the government has granted administrative approval to construct one lakh LIG houses in phases during the 2026–27 financial year. Chairing a review meeting with Housing Department officials at the Secretariat, the Minister said the initiative reflects Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy's commitment to fulfilling the housing aspirations of the urban poor. The government will begin the programme with a pilot phase, constructing 500 houses in each constituency, with the number increasing to 1,000 houses where required based on local conditions. The Minister stated that detailed guidelines, including eligibility criteria, application procedures, implementation modalities, and the tendering process, will be announced at the scheme's official launch. Ministers Ponnampati Prabhakar, Duddilla Sridhar Babu, and Mohammed Azharuddin will also participate in the announcement. Criticising the previous BRS government's double-bedroom housing programme, Ponguleti Srinivasa Reddy said many projects were built far from Hyderabad city, making them unsuitable for beneficiaries due to concerns over employment, education, healthcare, and transportation. In contrast, the present government plans to construct LIG housing on government land located within beneficiaries' own constituencies, ensuring easy access to workplaces, schools, hospitals, and public transport. He added that the government has already identified and taken possession of suitable lands across Hyderabad, Cyberabad, and Medchal–Malkajgiri municipal limits. The final project blueprint, including the number of dwelling units, building design, floor structure, and layout, will be finalized within the next two to three days after discussions with the Chief Minister. The Minister said the project is designed not only to provide quality housing but also to ensure long-term financial security for beneficiary families by granting ownership rights and a share in valuable urban land. The government expressed confidence that the Indiramma LIG Housing Scheme would transform the lives of thousands of economically weaker urban families while promoting inclusive urban development.

Healthy Ibrahimpatnam' Initiative: Health Minister Reviews Medical Facilities, Seeks Comprehensive Report

Hyderabad | July 14 | The Journalist Post : Telangana Health Minister Damodara Raja Narasimha and Ibrahimpatnam MLA Malreddy Ranga Reddy reviewed the healthcare infrastructure and medical services in the Ibrahimpatnam Assembly constituency, reaffirming the government's commitment to building a "Healthy Ibrahimpatnam" by strengthening government hospitals and expanding healthcare facilities. The review meeting was held at the State Secretariat on Tuesday in the presence of senior Health Department officials, including Principal Secretary Christina Z. Chongthu, Commissioner of Family Welfare Sangeetha Satyanarayana, Director of Health Ravindra Naik, Director of Medical Education Narendra Kumar, Ranga Reddy District DM&HO Swarna Kumari Reddy, DCHS Anuragini Reddy, and other officials. Minister Seeks Detailed Report During the meeting, Health Minister Damodara Raja Narasimha reviewed the availability of healthcare services, hospital infrastructure, medical equipment, manpower, and shortages of doctors and staff across the constituency. He directed officials to submit a comprehensive report by Saturday covering the current status of hospitals, infrastructure gaps, staffing requirements, and priority development works. The Minister emphasized that the government is committed to providing quality healthcare to every citizen and assured that the required funds would be made available for strengthening healthcare infrastructure. He instructed officials to ensure that public health services are delivered efficiently and without negligence. Corporate-Level Healthcare for the Poor MLA Malreddy Ranga Reddy said his vision is to provide corporate-standard healthcare services to economically weaker sections through government hospitals. He informed officials



that the Ibrahimpatnam Government Hospital is being upgraded into a super-specialty facility and that additional amenities would also be created at the temporary hospital premises to improve patient care. He stressed the need to strengthen all government hospitals and Primary Health Centres (PHCs) in the constituency so that people receive quality treatment close to their homes. Focus on Medicines, Staff Attendance and Emergency Care The MLA directed officials to ensure uninterrupted availability of medicines at all government hospitals and PHCs so that poor patients are not forced to purchase medicines from private pharmacies. He instructed doctors, nurses, and support staff to report for duty on time and called for strict monitoring of staff attendance to improve service delivery. He also emphasized the need to strengthen Basti Dawakhana and ensure the availability of duty doctors during night hours and emergencies. Vigilance Against Seasonal Diseases Malreddy Ranga Reddy also instructed health officials to intensify preventive measures against seasonal diseases, ensure the effective implementation of maternal and child healthcare programmes, encourage normal deliveries in government hospitals, and provide nutritious food to pregnant women under government welfare schemes. He directed officials to respond promptly to public grievances and ensure that patient complaints are addressed without delay, reiterating that quality healthcare should remain the top priority of the Health Department.

Tadicherla-2 Coal Block to Strengthen Singareni's Future, Says Senior Official



New mine expected to produce 6 million tonnes annually for 45 years, boosting SCCL's long-term growth.

Hyderabad | July 14 | The Journalist Post : The acquisition of the Tadicherla-2 coal block is a major boost for the Singareni Collieries Company Limited (SCCL) and will play a crucial role in ensuring the organization's long-term sustainability, according to T. Srinivas, General Manager (Coordination and Marketing). Speaking at a celebration held at Singareni Bhavan on Tuesday to mark the successful allocation of the Tadicherla-2 block, Srinivas said the company urgently requires new mines as several older mines are nearing closure. Warangal and Adilabad airports to be developed with world-class facilities; Centre responds positively to CM Revanth Reddy's proposals



New Delhi, July 14 (The Journalist Post): Telangana Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy urged Union Minister for Civil Aviation Rammohan Naidu to ensure the upcoming new airports at Warangal (Mamnoor) and Adilabad be constructed at international standards. The Chief Minister highlighted the strategic and commercial advantages of the two new airports in view of its locations in Telangana State. The CM met Rammohan Naidu at Rajiv Gandhi Bhavan, the Civil Aviation Ministry's office in Delhi on Tuesday. During the meeting, Revanth Reddy held extensive discussions with the Union Minister regarding the Warangal airport project. CM Revanth Reddy briefed Rammohan Naidu about the strategic location of the important city of Warangal, which is already connected by rail and road networks, and the hub of Kakatiya Mega Textile Park, Kazipet Coach Factory and other industries.

The Chief Minister informed the Union Minister that Warangal would witness robust growth in the industry once the airport started flight operations. Warangal would emerge as a central hub for the North Telangana districts of the erstwhile Adilabad, Karimnagar, Warangal, and Khammam regions, as well as Nalgonda, the CM said requested Rammohan Naidu to provide the “provision of MRO (Maintenance, Repair, and Overhaul), air cargo, and hangar facilities at the Warangal airport. Noting that land acquisition has already been completed, CM Revanth Reddy urged the Minister to invite tenders and commence the works expeditiously. The union minister has been requested to complete the airport construction and is ready for inauguration by June 2, 2028. During the discussion on Warangal airport designs, the Chief Minister asserted that Warangal's rich heritage of Kakatiya history and culture should be reflected. The union minister also assured that the CM request “ to establish a civil airport alongside the Defence-run airport in Adilabad will be taken into consideration. 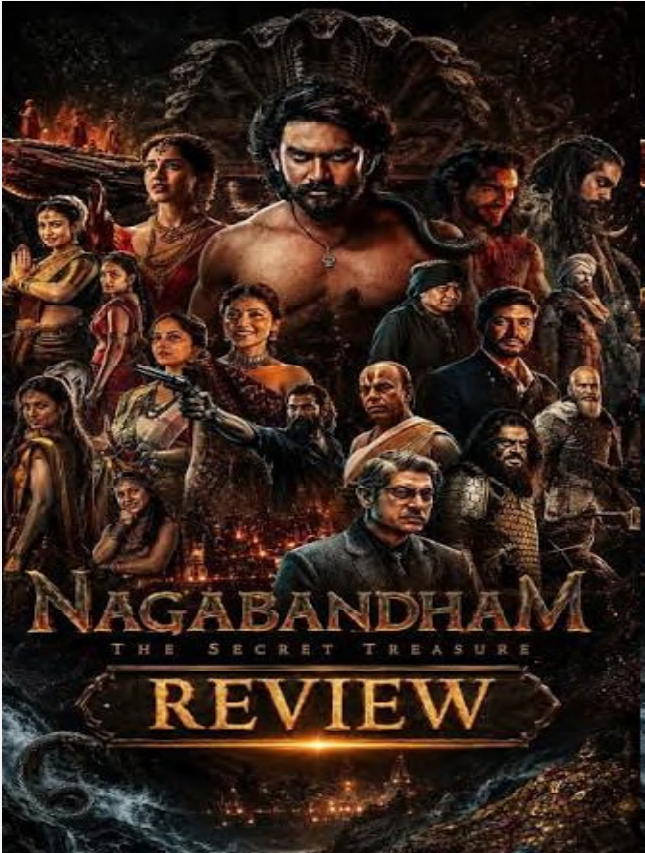
