Telangana Deputy Chief Minister and Energy Minister Mallu Bhatti Vikramarka on Tuesday said the allocation of the Tadicherla-2 Coal Block to Singareni Collieries Company Limited marks a major milestone for the State's coal sector and is the result of the Telangana Government's sustained efforts over the past two years. Welcoming the announcement made by Union Coal and Mines Minister G. Kishan Reddy, the Deputy Chief Minister said the allocation would provide Singareni with mining opportunities for another 40 years and significantly strengthen the company's long-term sustainability. He highlighted that the state's exceptional talent pool—particularly the skilled youth in the software and technology sectors—is a tremendous asset for investors. He revealed that major global corporations are increasingly choosing Hyderabad as a key hub for their global and data centers.

Bhatti Vikramarka remarked that Telangana is renowned for its hospitality and warmth. He remarked that the people of Telangana are known for their warm hospi-



tal and for welcoming guests graciously, noting that this is part of their tradition. The Deputy Chief Minister inquired about the impressions the Green Energy Summit delegates had formed of the city and wished them a successful visit. Organizer Rithvika Bhattacharya introduced the delegates, who had arrived from various countries for the summit, to the Deputy Chief Minister. Chief Secretary Sanjay Jaju, Special Chief Secretary (Energy) Navin Mittal, and others were present at the event.

Telangana to Build Permanent Revenue Offices at ₹360 Crore Cost: Ponguleti Srinivasa Reddy

Government to construct 170 permanent Revenue and Registration Department buildings to strengthen public service delivery across the state.

HYDERABAD, July 7 (The Journalist Post): Telangana Minister for Revenue, Housing, Information and Public Relations Ponguleti Srinivasa Reddy on Tuesday said the State Government is accelerating the construction of permanent buildings for Revenue Department offices to strengthen administration and provide faster, transparent, and citizen-friendly services.

Reviewing the progress of the projects with senior officials, the Minister announced that permanent buildings would be constructed in phases to replace offices currently functioning from rented or dilapidated premises. As part of the first phase, the government will construct 107 Tahsildar offices and 10 Revenue Divisional Officer (RDO) offices at an estimated cost of ₹263 crore. Under the Stamps and Registration Department, 48 Sub-Registrar offices, three District Registrar offices in Adilabad, Khammam, and Mahabubnagar, along with two Deputy Inspector General (DIG) offices in Nizamabad and Warangal, will be constructed at a cost of ₹97 crore.

The Minister said the government has accorded administrative sanction for projects worth ₹360 crore, covering both the Revenue and Registration Departments. Ponguleti Srinivasa Reddy stated that all the buildings would be constructed using a uniform design with modern infrastructure to ensure efficient, transparent, and technology-driven public services. The construction responsibility has been entrusted to the Telangana Housing Corporation. He said the initiative reflects the government's commitment, under the leadership of Chief

Minister A. Revanth Reddy, to improving public infrastructure and delivering better governance. Permanent government buildings, he noted, would eliminate the difficulties faced by citizens due to offices functioning from rented accommodations.

The Minister directed Housing Corporation officials to coordinate closely with district revenue authorities to identify suitable land parcels and expedite the commencement of construction works. He emphasized that Revenue and Registration offices should be established at easily accessible locations while also meeting future administrative requirements. Highlighting reforms in urban registration services, Ponguleti said 39 Sub-Registrar offices located within the Outer Ring Road (ORR) lim-

its are being reorganized into 13 integrated clusters. These integrated Sub-Registrar office complexes are being developed through partnerships with private construction agencies to avoid additional financial burden on the State Government. He added that the private agencies will also undertake the operation and maintenance of the integrated facilities for five years. Foundation stones have already been laid for integrated office complexes at four locations, and construction is progressing rapidly.

The Minister expressed confidence that the new infrastructure would modernize revenue administration, improve service delivery, and enhance public convenience across Telangana.

He criticised the previous BRS government for concentrating housing projects in a few constituencies while leaving many projects incomplete across the State. According to the Minister, unfinished housing projects in districts including Medak and Hyderabad are now being completed, with ownership documents being issued in the

names of women to promote women's empowerment.

Progress Under Indiramma Scheme

Ponguleti said approximately 1.30 lakh houses sanctioned during the first phase have already been completed and occupied, while another 70,000 to 75,000 houses have reached the slab stage. He reiterated that housing assistance is being provided to every eligible poor family irrespective of caste, religion, or political affiliation. Under the second phase launched by Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy, the government has sanctioned 2.5 lakh houses, targeting 2,000 houses in each Assembly constituency. The programme includes funding for 1,500 new houses and the completion of 500 unfinished houses in every constituency. The Minister said the government's objective is to ensure permanent housing for every deserving family while completing all pending housing projects across Telangana.

DGP C.V. Anand Calls for ‘Back to Basics’ Policing During Khammam Crime Review

KHAMMAM, July 7 (The Journalist Post): Director General of Police (DGP) C.V. Anand on Tuesday called for a return to "Back to Basics" policing, stressing that effective law enforcement must be built on integrity, visibility, impartiality, professionalism, and technology. Chairing a comprehensive crime review meeting in Khammam, the DGP assessed the district's law and order situation and reviewed crime trends. He identified shortcomings in existing crime-control strategies and instructed officers to adopt corrective measures for improving policing standards and investigation quality.

During the review, officials informed the DGP that financial fraud cases had increased by 30 percent, while job fraud cases registered a 36 percent rise. Cases involving fake documents were also on the rise, and GST-related offences are now being investigated by the police. Reviewing cybercrime, the DGP said fraudsters had cheated 711 victims of approximately Rs 9.48 crore in the district during the current year. Police have recovered around Rs 1.41 crore so far and are continuing efforts to trace the remaining funds and bring the offenders to justice.

On the anti-narcotics front, C.V. Anand noted that 1,700 kilograms of ganja had been seized this year, making Khammam one of the highest ganja seizure districts in Telangana. He directed officers to intensify the campaign against narcotics, stating that protecting the younger generation from drug abuse must remain a top policing priority. As

part of initiatives to strengthen public safety, the DGP inaugurated the Road



Safety Park, 250 newly installed CCTV cameras connected to the district Command Centre, and the Commissionerate's CCTV Command Facility. He appreciated citizens who voluntarily installed surveillance cameras in their villages to assist police in crime prevention.

The DGP also interacted with students, creating awareness about

traffic discipline and road safety while distributing helmets. He noted that road accidents in the district had reduced significantly, with 146 accidents recorded this year compared to 317 during the corresponding period last year. During the review meeting, C.V. Anand instructed officers to strengthen night patrolling, maintain strict discipline in updating the Crime and Criminal Tracking Network & Systems (CCTNS) database, and avoid unnecessary police interference in civil and land disputes by strictly following Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs). He directed police to intensify action against sand mafia, soil mafia, rowdy elements, and other organized criminal networks by effectively utilizing advanced digital policing platforms such as CCTNS 3.0, Hawk Eye 3.0, and TG

COPS 3.0.

He also announced that a Traffic Management Bureau, on the lines of the EAGLE enforcement unit, would be established soon. Addressing police personnel, the DGP reminded them that wearing the police uniform is both an honour and a responsibility. Only a very small fraction of our population gets the privilege of serving in the police force. Wear the uniform with integrity and dedication, or do not wear it at all," he told the officers. The DGP also participated in Vanamahotsavam celebrations by planting saplings, reiterating the importance of environmental conservation alongside public service.

BRS Alleges Rs 10,000-Crore Land Scam, Seeks High-Level Probe into ‘22,000 Illegal Transfers’

mandated a high-level inquiry into what he claimed were 22,000 illegal land ownership transfers carried out through manipulation of revenue software.

Addressing a press conference, Praveen Kumar accused Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy and Revenue Minister Ponguleti Srinivasa Reddy of failing to prevent large-scale irregularities in the Revenue and Registration departments. According to the BRS leader, nearly 22,000 land records were allegedly transferred to third parties without the knowledge or consent of the original landowners, District Collectors, or other revenue authorities. He further alleged that even lands classified under the prohibited category were transferred by manipulating software.

Calls for High-Level Investigation

Praveen Kumar demanded an independent, high-level investigation into the alleged transactions and questioned why no criminal cases had been registered despite the seriousness of the allegations. He also accused the government of adopting a selective approach towards Anti Corruption Bureau (ACB) investigations, alleging that corruption cases were initiated only in politically convenient circumstances.

Questions Bhu Bharati System

The BRS leader criticised the replacement of the Dharani portal with the Bhu Bharati land management system, alleging that the new platform had enabled illegal land transfers rather than improving transparency. He urged citizens to verify their land records through the Bhu Bharati portal and check their Encumbrance Certificates (ECs) to ensure that ownership details remained unchanged.

Praveen Kumar alleged that illegal mutations had occurred in districts surrounding Hyderabad, including Ranga Reddy, Medchal-Malkajgiri, Sangareddy, Siddipet and Rajanna Sircilla. Refers to Jangaon Revenue Scam Referring to the alleged revenue scam in Jangaon district, Praveen Kumar questioned why no arrests had



been made despite earlier announcements of an inquiry and a forensic audit. He alleged that similar irregularities had continued from 2024 through June 2026 and cited alleged land transfers involving properties in

Khajaguda, including parcels reportedly transferred to a private company.

Alleges Violation of Revenue Rules

Citing Rule 4 of the Record of Rights (ROR) Rules, the BRS leader alleged that mandatory notices to both buyers and sellers had not been issued before several land mutations were approved. He questioned how thousands of land transfers could occur without the knowledge of Mandal Revenue Officers (MROs), Revenue Divisional Officers (RDOs), District Collectors or the Chief Commissioner of Land Administration (CCLA).

Praveen Kumar further alleged that farmers and landowners affected by disputed transfers were being forced to approach courts while encroachments continued unabated. He also questioned the government's handling of appointments within the Revenue Department and alleged irregularities in postings and promotions. Demanding accountability, the BRS leader called upon the government to make public the findings of the committee investigating the Jangaon revenue scam and initiate criminal action against those responsible for the alleged illegal land transfers. The Telangana Government had not officially responded to these allegations at the time of publication.

DGP C.V. Anand Reviews Ground-Level Policing During Visit to Khammam

KHAMMAM, July 7 (The Journalist Post): Director General of Police (DGP) C.V. Anand on Tuesday reaffirmed the importance of field-level policing, stating that direct interaction with district officials and on-ground assessments are vital for strengthening law enforcement and public safety across Telangana. After concluding his visit to Kothagudem, the DGP arrived in Khammam on Monday night, where he was received by District Collector Divakara, IAS, Khammam Commissioner of Police Sunil Dutt, IPS, and other senior district officials.

Speaking about his visit, C.V. Anand said field inspections remain central to his approach to policing, as they provide an opportunity to directly review preparedness, understand district-specific challenges, and assess the implementation of policing strategies at the grassroots level. He emphasized that no review conducted from headquarters can replace firsthand interaction with officers and field assessments, which

Serial House Burglar Arrested in Hayathnagar; Gold, Silver Worth Lakhs and Cash Recovered



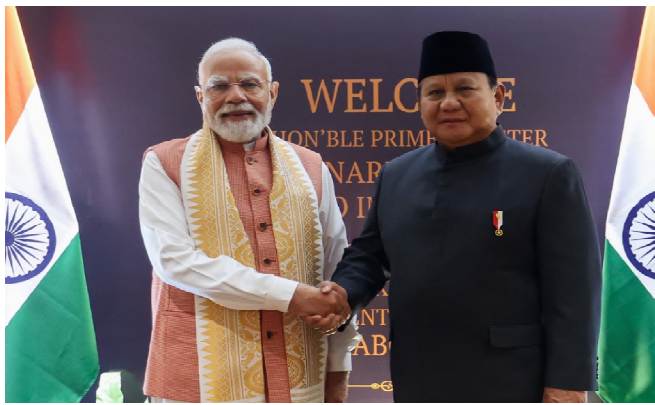
than 70 house burglary cases across Telangana over the past two decades, was apprehended on Tuesday following a special operation conducted on the directions of Malkajgiri Police Commissioner B. Sumathi. According to police, the arrested accused has been identified as Sriram Narasimha Chari alias Nayami alias Rajesh (39), a resident of Vajpayee Nagar in Chintal under Jeedimetla. He worked as a driver and carpenter but allegedly turned to house burglaries to finance a lavish lifestyle. Police said he had discontinued his education after Class VII and gradually became involved in a series of property offences across several police station limits in Telangana. Acting on credible intelligence, Hayathnagar police personnel intercepted the accused at Munaganur at around 10.30 a.m. on July 7 after noticing his suspicious movements during plainclothes patrolling. During the initial inquiry, police recovered Rs 42,000 in cash from his possession. As he failed to provide a satisfactory explanation regarding the money, he was taken into custody and interrogated. During questioning, the accused allegedly confessed to his involvement in four recent house burglary cases registered at Hayathnagar Police Station under Crime Nos. 630/2026, 639/2026, 1107/2026 and 1110/2026, booked under Sections 331(3) and 305(a) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS). Based on his confession, police recovered the stolen property from his residence.

The recovered property includes approximately 42.3 tolas of gold jewellery, comprising mangalsutras, long and short chains, bangles, rings, earrings, necklaces, bracelets, children's ornaments and pendants. Police also recovered about 87 tolas of silver articles, including anklets, waist belts and puja items, besides Rs 42,000 in cash. The total value of the seized property is estimated to run into several lakhs of rupees. Investigators said the accused targeted locked houses during daytime after conducting reconnaissance of residential colonies. He allegedly used tools such as screwdrivers, surgical gloves and face masks while committing the burglaries to avoid leaving evidence. According to the investigation, the stolen gold ornaments were either hidden at his residence or sold to contacts identified through online platforms, while a substantial portion of the money was reportedly lost in online betting.

Police stated that on April 15, the accused allegedly broke into a locked house within Hayathnagar limits, forced open an almirah and escaped with gold ornaments and cash. The following day, he allegedly committed burglaries at two houses in Dwaraka Venkatasai Nagar, Munaganur, stealing gold, silver articles and cash. On June 29, he allegedly struck again at two houses in the same locality, stealing gold ornaments, silver items and cash, including Rs 60,000 from one residence. Officials further revealed that the accused had previously been arrested in November 2025 in connection with a burglary case registered at Chandanagar Police Station. After being transferred to Bhongir Jail in connection with a pending non-bailable warrant, he was released on bail in January 2026. Police alleged that he resumed criminal activities shortly after his release due to financial difficulties.

Preliminary investigation indicates that the accused has an extensive criminal record dating back to 2004, with burglary cases registered in several police stations, including Pet Basheerabad, Neredmet, Jangaon, Nacharam, Malkajgiri and Bowenpally. Authorities are compiling details of all previous cases registered against him to determine the full extent of his criminal history. Police said further investigation is in progress to identify receivers of the stolen property, verify the accused's involvement in other unsolved burglary cases and trace additional stolen valuables. Officials also suspect that more recoveries may be made during the course of the investigation.

BRS Should Speak Less About Kaleshwaram: TPCC Chief Mahesh Kumar Goud

HYDERABAD, July 7 (The Journalist Post): Telangana Pradesh Congress Committee (TPCC) President and MLC Mahesh Kumar Goud on Tuesday launched a sharp attack on the Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) over the Kaleshwaram Lift Irrigation Project, alleging that the previous government compromised the project's quality through corruption and unscientific execution. Responding to recent remarks made by BRS Working President K. T. Rama Rao (KTR), Mahesh Kumar Goud said the less the BRS speaks about Kaleshwaram, the better, alleging that the project had been plagued by large-scale irregularities during the previous government's tenure.

He claimed that the Kaleshwaram project suffered because engineering expertise was ignored and alleged that decisions were taken without following technical advice. According to him, the quality of the project was compromised after engineers were sidelined, resulting in structural issues that later emerged at key barrages.

Questioning KTR's recent statements regarding the operation of the project, Mahesh



Kumar Goud asked what the BRS had achieved during its nine-and-a-half years in power despite having complete control over the irrigation system. He alleged that the previous government's decisions had placed the future of the project at risk.

The TPCC President also criticized KTR's demand to resume pumping operations immediately, stating that operating the barrages without obtaining the necessary clearances from the National Dam Safety Authority (NDSA) and the

Central Water Commission (CWC) would be unsafe. He said technical reports had identified concerns relating to the foundations and structural condition of the Medigadda, Annaram, and Sundilla barrages, making it inappropriate to resume operations before completing restoration works.

Mahesh Kumar Goud asserted that storing water or operating pumps before addressing the identified deficiencies would be unscientific and could pose risks to public safety. He maintained that the Congress government, under Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy, is committed to restoring the Kaleshwaram project based on expert technical assessments rather than political considerations. He concluded by stating that the Congress government would continue to focus on scientifically restoring the irrigation infrastructure while protecting the interests of Telangana's farmers and the public.

He noted that Anganwadi centres are already benefiting lakhs of children across Telangana and described the mobile Anganwadi concept as an innovative step toward extending these services to underserved communities. Children of migrant workers often miss out on nutrition,

address Hyderabad's worsening drinking water crisis despite the arrival of the monsoon. She claimed that the continued dependence on water tankers reflects the administration's lack of planning and accused the government of prioritising political and financial interests over the needs of the people.

Responding to the issue through a post on the social media platform X, Kavitha expressed concern that nearly 10,000 water tankers are being booked every day in Hyderabad even during July, indicating the seriousness of the city's drinking water shortage. She said the situation demonstrates the government's inability to ensure an adequate and reliable drinking water supply for residents of the State capital.

Kavitha alleged that instead of implementing the originally planned drinking water scheme from Konda Pochamma Sagar to meet Hyderabad's long-term water requirements, the government proceeded with Phases II and III of the Godavari Drinking Water Project from Mallanna Sagar. She claimed that the decision was taken to benefit a particular company and facilitate large commissions, rather than to serve the public interest. According to her, the diversion of the project has left Hyderabad residents

struggling for drinking water while those in power pursue financial gains.

The Telangana Rakshana Sena chief further criticised the government for failing to prepare adequately despite repeated warnings about the possible impact of El Niño. She alleged that the administration lacked even a basic advance plan to prevent water shortages and had not taken precautionary measures to safeguard Hyderabad's drinking water needs before the onset of the crisis.

Calling for immediate action, Kavitha urged the government to prioritise the drinking water needs of Hyderabad's residents and expedite the completion of the pending Godavari Drinking Water Project works. She maintained that timely execution of the project is essential to provide a permanent solution to the city's recurring water shortages. The remarks come amid growing public concern over drinking water availability in Hyderabad, with several localities continuing to depend on private water tankers despite the ongoing monsoon season.

Sanathnagar TIMS to Be Developed as State's Organ Transplant Hub: Minister Damodar Raja Narasimha

Health Minister reviews advanced facilities, directs phased launch of transplant services and integration with NIMS to reduce patient waiting time.

HYDERABAD, July 7 (The Journalist Post): Telangana Health Minister Damodar Raja Narasimha on Monday announced that the Telangana Institute of Medical Sciences (TIMS), Sanathnagar, is being developed into a comprehensive Centre of Excellence for Organ Transplantation, with facilities to perform all major organ transplant surgeries under one roof.

The Minister visited the Sanathnagar TIMS campus along with transplant surgeons from NIMS, Osmania Hospital, and Gandhi Hospital to review the progress of the facility. During the inspection, he examined the state-of-the-art modular operation theatres, intensive care units (ICUs), pre-operative and post-operative wards, and other advanced medical infrastructure before holding a review meeting with senior doctors and health officials.

Damodar Raja Narasimha said the State Government's objective is to strengthen public healthcare by providing world-class super-specialty medical services through government hospitals. He noted that Telangana's government doctors possess exceptional expertise and are already performing complex organ transplant procedures successfully. The Minister said Sanathnagar TIMS would emerge as a premier public-sector institution offering comprehensive transplant services, cardiothoracic surgeries, super-specialty treatment, medical education, and research. He invited transplant specialists to submit recommendations for further enhancing patient care and expanding transplant services.

Transplant surgeons informed the Minister that

the hospital has already been equipped with the essential infrastructure required for organ transplantation, including modern modular operation theatres, advanced ICUs, and sophisticated medical equipment. They stated that various transplant procedures could begin in a phased manner since the core infrastructure is already in place. Assuring full government support, the Minister said any additional requirements identified by the medical



teams would be addressed promptly to strengthen the hospital's capabilities. During the review, surgeons from NIMS highlighted that while expert specialists are available in departments such as neurosurgery, cardiothoracic surgery, and urology, the limited number of operation theatres often results in delays and longer waiting periods for patients.

In response, Damodar Raja Narasimha directed officials to prepare an action plan enabling patients awaiting super-specialty proce-

dures—including neurosurgeries, kidney transplants, and cardiac surgeries at NIMS—to undergo treatment at Sanathnagar TIMS once full-scale operations commence. He instructed Director of Medical Education Dr. Narendra Kumar to make the necessary administrative arrangements to facilitate the de-

ployment of medical teams from NIMS to Sanathnagar TIMS for conducting surgeries without delay.

The Minister further announced that Sanathnagar TIMS would function as an autonomous institution on the lines of NIMS, with recruitment of doctors and other staff following a similar administrative framework. He expressed confidence that the development of TIMS into a major transplant and super-specialty centre would significantly reduce the patient load on NIMS, Gandhi Hospital, and Osmania Hospital while shortening waiting periods for life-saving surgeries and improving access to advanced healthcare. The review meeting was attended by Director of Medical Education Dr. Narendra Kumar, former NIMS Director Dr. Beerappa, Gandhi Hospital Superintendent Dr. Vani, Osmania Hospital Superintendent Dr. Rakesh Sahay, Jeevandan in-charge Dr. Bhushan Raj, and transplant specialists from NIMS, Gandhi, and Osmania hospitals, including Dr. Madhusudan, Dr. Manisha Sahay, Dr. Gangadhar, and other senior medical professionals.
